The students are in the school library. They are researches information for a project on class. They are using the laptops. They are looking up important information.

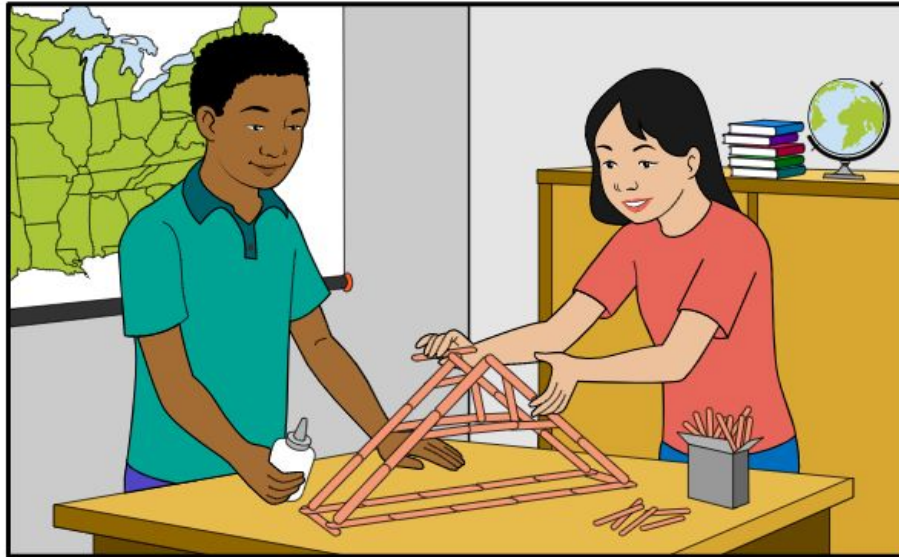
